


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
Sexual Harassment Sexual Harassment Sexual Harassment means conduct on the basis of sex that satisfies one or more of the following: Quid pro quo—An employee of the recipient conditioning the provision of an aid, benefit, or service of the recipient on an individual's participation in unwelcome sexual conduct Hostile environment — Unwelcome conduct determined by a reasonable person to be so severe, pervasive, and objectively offensive that it effectively denies a person equal access to the recipient's education program or activity; or Clery crimes — Sexual assault, dating violence, domestic violence, or stalking [Clery regulatory definition cites omitted]



Sexual Assault: - Sexual Assault: An offense that meets the definition of rape, fondling, incest or statutory rape as used in the IBIS Come Reporting system. A sex offense is any sexual act directed against another person, without the consulter of the venture, including unstances where the venture is unapplied of giving consultation. - Raper: The penetration, no matter how slight, of the vagina or arms with any body part or object, or or all penetration by a sex organ of another person, without the consent of the victim. - Fondling: The touching of the private body parts of another person for the purpose of sexual gratification, sometimes of the person of the purpose of sexual gratification, and the person of the person of the purpose of sexual gratification, and the person of the perso

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


















- Coordinate response to all complaints involving Sexual Harassment
- Provide and track Supportive Measures
 Monitor investigations, resolutions, outcomes, remedies and sanctions
- Monitor patterns and trends
- Avoid Conflicts of Interest and biases Update Policies and Procedures
- Recordkeeping
